## THE WAY OF SALVATION

- 1. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
  - A. Without Jesus all people are lost.
  - B. All have sin and God's standard is perfection.

    There is no difference since all have sinned we all sinners and it does not help us that we are a better sinner than someone else we are still a sinner.
  - C. All have sinned so we can not save our selves.
- 2. Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
  - A. The wages of sin is Death.
    - 1) Everyone has earned death because of their sin.
  - B. God made Jesus to be the way for us.
    - 1) Jesus was made to be the way for us to receive eternal life.
    - 2) Eternal life is a gift from God.
- 3. Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
  - A. God love us so much that Jesus died for us.
  - B. By Jesus death we receive eternal life.
- 4. Ephesians 2:8-10 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
  - A. Salvation is a gift that God gives us freely it does not come from our works.
  - B. The gift of Salvation is received by faith in what Jesus did for us.
- 5. John 3:15-17 That whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. 16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
  - A. God love us so much that He gave His only Son for us.
  - B. So anyone the puts his faith in Jesus, he will receive eternal life.
- 6. John 1:1,14 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God 14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

- A. Jesus is God. Jesus is not only a prophet and/or a good man but He is God.
- B. Jesus was born as a man the He would be able to take on Himself our sins and pay the penalty for our sin.
- 7. 1 Peter 2:24 Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness by whose stripes you were healed.
  - A. Jesus took our sins in His body on the Cross to pay our debt of sin.
  - B. Jesus took our sins so that we would be able to be free from sin and it's penalty.
- 8. 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
  - A. Jesus did not sin, He was the sinless Son of God.
  - B. God put our sin on Jesus.
  - C. The reason God put our sin on Jesus is so we might receive His righteousness.
- 9. 2 Corinthians 5:17-18 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 18 Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation.
  - A. Jesus died to make us a new creature. The old man that committed sin was put on the cross of Jesus and we become new creature in Christ.
  - B. The new creatures that we become in Christ is from God and as so complete and righteous.
- 10. Romans 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
  - A. Faith is to Believe in your heart that Jesus died and was risen again. That is:
    - 1) Jesus is God.
    - 2) He took our sin in His body.
    - 3) He died for our sin.
    - 4) He was raised again so that we could be raised up together with Him.
  - B. Faith changes our lives. It is not believing that Jesus died, but it is Believing that Jesus rose rom the dead changes our lives.
  - C. And to Confess that Jesus is Lord.
    - 1) Is to confess that we no longer obey satan and sin.
    - 2) And now we obey Jesus and we give our lives to Him to be His servant.
